FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to violations of domestic violence protective orders."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 * **Section 1.** AS 11.56.740(a) is amended to read:
- 4 (a) A person commits the crime of violating a protective order if the person is
- 5 subject to a protective order containing a provision listed in AS 18.66.100(c)(1) (7)
- and knowingly commits or attempts to commit an act with reckless disregard that
- 7 the act violates or would violate a provision [IN VIOLATION] of the protective
- 8 <u>order</u> [THAT PROVISION.]
