1 "An Act relating to the crime of failure to stop at the direction of a peace officer; and

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AS 28.35.182(a) is amended to read: 5 (a) A person commits the offense of failure to stop at the direction of a peace 6 officer in the first degree if the person violates (b) of this section, and, during the 7 commission of that offense, 8 (1) the person violates <u>AS 28.35.040;</u> 9 (2) the person is committing vehicle theft in the first or second 10 degree; or 11 (3) as a result of the person's operation or driving, an accident 12 occurs or a person suffers serious physical injury; in this paragraph, "serious 13 physical injury" has the meaning given in AS 11.81.900 [A TRAFFIC LAW OR 14 COMMITS ANOTHER CRIME. IN THIS SUBSECTION,
