FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to periods of probation for state employees; and providing for an
- 2 effective date."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- *** Section 1.** AS 39.25.150(7) is amended to read:
- 5 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year before an appointment 6 to a position becomes permanent, unless the period of probation is extended as set 7 out in a collective bargaining agreement under AS 23.40; however, [EXCEPT 8 THAT] a permanent employee receiving a promotional appointment retains permanent 9 status in the service and job class from which appointed for the duration of the 10 probationary period and may be demoted to a former class without right of appeal, 11 notwithstanding AS 39.25.170, but, if the employee is dismissed from the service, the 12 appeal rights under AS 39.25.170 apply;
- * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
