## **A BILL**

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to results of testing for paralytic shellfish poisoning and to
- 2 participation of the Department of Environmental Conservation in the development of
- 3 operating plans of qualified regional dive fishery development associations."
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- \* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
  to read:
- 7 LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of
- 8 Environmental Conservation promptly distribute the results of testing conducted by or on
- 9 behalf of the department for paralytic shellfish poisoning for species harvested by members of
- 10 regional dive fishery development associations through an Internet web site of the department.
- \* **Sec. 2.** AS 43.76.200(b) is amended to read:
- 12 (b) The Department of Fish and Game shall develop an annual operating plan
- with the cooperation of the regional dive fishery development association and the
- 14 <u>Department of Environmental Conservation</u> on or before a date specified by the

Department of Fish and Game. The qualified regional dive fishery development association and the Department of Environmental Conservation shall cooperate with the Department of Fish and Game in the development of the annual operating plan. The annual operating plan must describe the activities for which the funding will be expended, including identification of species and areas for which bioassessment surveys will be conducted, a description of management and research activities to be performed, planning for dive fisheries, and administrative activities of the association. Funds appropriated to the Department of Fish and Game for funding of qualified regional dive fishery development associations may not be disbursed by the department or expended by the association, except for administration of the association, unless the annual operating plan has been approved by the association and the Department of Fish and Game. If an annual operating plan has not been approved by the association and the Department of Fish and Game, the Department of Fish and Game may not disburse and the association may not expend funds received from the department for administration of the association in an amount that exceeds the amount of administrative expenses authorized under the annual operating plan for the prior fiscal year.
