# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to the award of a high school diploma to certain World War II
  2 veterans."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- \* **Section 1.** AS 14.03 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 14.03.077. High school diploma for certain veterans. (a)
  Notwithstanding other provisions of this chapter, the commissioner shall award a high
  school diploma to a person who
- 8 (1) makes application under (b) of this section; if a person is deceased or incapacitated, an immediate family member may apply on behalf of the person;
- 10 (2) never received a high school diploma; and
- 11 (3) actively served in the United States armed forces or the Alaska
- Territorial Guard during the period of August 7, 1940, through July 25, 1947, and
- 13 (A) died in active service;
- 14 (B) was honorably discharged; or

l	(C) was released from active duty because of a service-related
2	disability.
3	(b) The commissioner shall provide a form or electronic format for a person to
4	apply under this section. The commissioner may accept an affidavit to support the
5	award if documentation is not readily available from the military or other sources.
