A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act exempting from the category of public records certain records and information

2 relating to state safety plans, programs, and procedures, and to systems, facilities, and

3 infrastructure in the state; and providing for an effective date."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5 * Section 1. AS 40.25.120(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

6 (10) records or information pertaining to a plan, program, or 7 procedures for establishing, maintaining, or restoring security in the state, or to a 8 detailed description or evaluation of systems, facilities, or infrastructure in the state, 9 but only to the extent that the production of the records or information

- 10 (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with the 11 implementation or enforcement of the security plan, program, or procedures;
- (B) would disclose confidential guidelines for investigations or
 enforcement and the disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk
 circumvention of the law; or

1 (C) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or 2 physical safety of an individual or to present a real and substantial risk to the 3 public health and welfare.

4 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
