FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act defining the term 'mental health professional' for the purpose of statutes 2 relating to the evaluation of prisoners who may need psychological or psychiatric 3 treatment, for the purpose of statutes relating to the evaluation of children in need of aid 4 and delinquent minors who may need to be confined in a secure residential psychiatric 5 treatment center or who should be released from such a center, for the purpose of 6 statutes requiring certain professionals to report the possibility that a vulnerable adult 7 has been abused or neglected, and for the purpose of statutes relating to mental health 8 civil commitments."
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 47.30.915(11) is amended to read:
- 11 (11) "mental health professional" means a psychiatrist or physician 12 who is licensed by the State Medical Board to practice in this state or is employed by

the federal government; a clinical psychologist licensed by the state Board of
Psychologist and Psychological Associate Examiners; a psychological associate
trained in clinical psychology and licensed by the Board of Psychologist and
Psychological Associate Examiners; a registered nurse with a master's degree in
psychiatric nursing, licensed by the State Board of Nursing; a marital and family
therapist licensed by the Board of Marital and Family Therapy; a professional
counselor licensed by the Board of Professional Counselors; [AND] a clinical
social worker licensed by the Board of Social Work Examiners; and a person who
(A) has [WITH] a master's degree in the field of mental
health;
(B) has at least 12 months of post-masters working [IN
SOCIAL WORK AND SUBSTANTIAL] experience in the field of mental
illness <u>; and</u>
(C) is working under the supervision of a type of licensee
listed in this paragraph;
