A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State**
2 **Legislature, concerning House Bill No. 177, placing certain special interest organizations**
3 **within the definition of "group" for purposes of Alaska's campaign finance statutes; and**
4 **requiring disclosure of the true source of campaign contributions.**

5 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

6 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
7 Rules 24(c), 35, 41(b), and 42(e), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, regarding
8 changes to the title of a bill, are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 177, placing
9 certain special interest organizations within the definition of "group" for purposes of Alaska's
10 campaign finance statutes; and requiring disclosure of the true source of campaign
11 contributions.
