1	Relating to the issuance of a search warrant upon the sworn testimony or affidavit of a person
2	communicated by telephone, other appropriate means, or facsimile machine.

4	* Section 1. AS 12.35.015(a) is amended to read:
5	(a) A judicial officer may issue a search warrant upon the sworn oral
6	testimony of a person communicated by telephone or other appropriate means, or
7	sworn affidavit transmitted by facsimile machine, if the judicial officer finds that there
8	is probable cause to believe that
9	(1) the presentation of the applicant's affidavit or testimony personally
10	before the judicial officer would result in <u>a</u> delay in obtaining <u>or executing</u> a search
11	warrant [AND IN EXECUTING THE SEARCH]; and
12	(2) the delay might result in loss or destruction of the evidence subject
13	to seizure or might interfere with an ongoing investigation.
