1	Relating to advancement in public schools of children under school age.

3	* Section 1. AS 14.03.080(c) is amended to read:
4	(c) A child under school age may be admitted to the public school in the
5	school district of which the child is a resident at the discretion of the governing body
6	of the school district if the child meets minimum standards prescribed by the board
7	evidencing that the child has the mental, physical, and emotional capacity to perform
8	satisfactorily for the educational program being offered. A district's educational
9	program must prescribe that under school age students advance through the
10	curriculum or grade level by the following school year.
