3 * **Section 1.** AS 16.05.835(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) **Unless the Board of Fisheries has provided by regulation for the use of**
5 **a longer vessel in a salmon seine fishery, a** [A] salmon seine vessel may not be
6 longer than 58 feet overall length except vessels that have fished for salmon with
7 seines in waters of the state before January 1, 1962, as 50-foot, official Coast Guard
8 register length vessels.

9 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2005.
