5 * Section 1. AS 09.50.250 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 09.50.250. Actionable claims against the state. A person or corporation 7 having a contract, quasi-contract, or tort claim against the state may bring an action 8 against the state. A person who may present the claim under AS 44.77 may not bring 9 an action under this section except as set out in AS 44.77.040(c). A person who may 10 bring an action under AS 36.30.560 - 36.30.695 may not bring an action under this 11 section except as set out in AS 36.30.685. However, an action may not be brought 12 [UNDER THIS SECTION] if the claim

(1) is an action for tort, and is based upon an act or omission of an
employee of the state, exercising due care, in the execution of a statute or regulation,

whether or not the statute or regulation is valid; or is an action for tort, and based upon
 the exercise or performance or the failure to exercise or perform a discretionary
 function or duty on the part of a state agency or an employee of the state, whether or
 not the discretion involved is abused;

5 (2) is for damages caused by the imposition or establishment of a 6 quarantine by the state;

7 (3) arises out of assault, battery, false imprisonment, false arrest,
8 malicious prosecution, abuse of process, libel, slander, misrepresentation, deceit, or
9 interference with contract rights; [OR]

10 (4) arises out of the use of an ignition interlock device certified under
11 AS 33.05.020(c); or

(5) <u>arises out of injury, illness, or death of a seaman that occurs or</u>
 manifests itself during or in the course of, or arises out of, employment with the
 state; AS 23.30 provides the exclusive remedy for such a claim, and no action
 may be brought against the state, its vessels, or its employees under the Jones Act
 (46 U.S.C. 688), in admiralty, or under the general maritime law.

* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
read:

APPLICABILITY. (a) AS 09.50.250(5), enacted by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to
 claims or causes of action accruing on or after the effective date of this Act.

(b) Nothing in this Act affects the terms of a collective bargaining agreement in effecton the effective date of this Act.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2003.
