 - * **Sec. 4.** AS 41.21.510(b) is amended to read:
 - (b) The advisory board appointed under this section shall be representative of user groups, resident property owners, municipalities <u>adjacent to the Kenai River</u> [, AGENCIES OF THE STATE AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENTS], and other interest groups. <u>Unless appointed as a representative of a user group, resident property owners, a municipality adjacent to the Kenai River, or another interest group, an employee, elected official, or other representative of a federal or state government may be appointed to the advisory board only as an ex officio member serving without a vote. A majority of the <u>voting</u> members of the advisory group shall be residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.</u>
