4	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 22, ch. 109, SLA
5	2003, is amended to read:
6	Sec. 22. TRANSITION: ACTIVITIES INVOLVING UNSTAMPED
7	CIGARETTES THROUGH JUNE 30 [MARCH 31], 2004. (a) Notwithstanding the
8	requirements of AS 43.50.500 - 43.50.700, enacted by sec. 19 of this Act, a person
9	may acquire, hold, own, import, possess, sell, distribute, or consume unstamped
10	cigarettes in this state on or after January 1, 2004, and on or before June 30
11	[MARCH 31], 2004, if the cigarettes were in this state before January 1, 2004.
12	(b) In this section, "unstamped cigarettes" has the meaning given in
13	AS 43.50.700, enacted by sec. 19 of this Act.
14	* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
