11	including a general partnership, a registered limited liability partnership, a limited
12	partnership, a limited liability limited partnership, [AND] a foreign limited liability
13	company, and a corporation as allowed under (i) of this section.
14	* Sec. 3. AS 10.50.570 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

- (j) A corporation may convert to a limited liability company under this section
   if the corporation is a subsidiary corporation that is owned directly or indirectly by one
   or more parent corporations.
- \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 2004.
