6 No money appropriated in this appropriation may be expended for an abortion that is not a 7 mandatory service required under AS 47.07.030(a). The money appropriated for Health and 8 Social Services may be expended only for mandatory services required under Title XIX of the 9 Social Security Act and for optional services offered by the state under the state plan for 10 medical assistance that has been approved by the United States Department of Health and 11 Human Services. This statement is a statement of the purpose of the appropriation and is 12 neither merely descriptive language nor a statement of legislative intent.

13 It is the intent of the legislature that the Department continues to aggressively pursue 14 Medicaid cost containment initiatives undertaken in fiscal 2005. While individual 15 components of the original initiatives may be unattainable, work should continue on others 16 where the Department believes additional cost containment is possible including further 17 efforts to contain travel expenses. The Department must initiate efforts imposing regulations 18 controlling and materially reducing the cost of Personal Care Attendant (PCA) services. 19 Efforts must be initiated to impose regulations screening applicants for Residential Psychiatric 20 Treatment Center (RPTC) services, especially for out-of-state services. The department must 21 address the entire matrix of optional Medicaid services, reimbursement rates and eligibility 22 requirements that are the basis of the Medicaid growth algorithm. This work is to utilize the 23 results of the Medicaid Assessment and Planning analysis that was funded in the FY05 budget 24 and will be available in early FY06. The legislature requests that by January 2006 the 25 Department be prepared to present projections of future Medicaid funding requirements under 26 our existing statute and regulations and be prepared to present and evaluate the consequences 27 of viable policy alternatives that could be implemented to lower growth rates and reducing 28 projections of future costs.
