4 * **Section 1.** AS 11.71.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (e) Schedule IA includes, unless specifically excepted or unless listed in
6 another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any
7 quantity of the following substances, or which contains any of its salts, isomers,
8 whether optical, position, or geometric, or salts of isomers whenever the existence of
9 those salts, isomers, or salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical
10 designation:

11 (1) gamma-hydroxybutyric acid (GHB) (some other names include
12 gamma-hydroxybutyrate; 4-hydroxybutyrate; 4-hydroxybutanoic acid; sodium
13 oxybate; sodium oxybutyrate);

14 (2) when intended or used for human consumption:

- 1 (A) gamma butyrolactone (GBL);
- 2 (B) 1,4 butanediol (BD);
- 3 (C) gamma hydroxyvalerate (GHV);
- 4 (D) gamma-valerolactone 4-pentanolide (GVL).
- 5 * **Sec. 2.** AS 11.71.170(b)(28) is repealed.
