1 Relating to scheduling as a Schedule IA controlled substance gamma-hydroxybutyric acid and 2 certain similar substances. 3 4 * **Section 1.** AS 11.71.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: 5 Schedule IA includes, unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation which contains any 6 7 quantity of the following substances, or which contains any of its salts, isomers, 8 whether optical, position, or geometric, or salts of isomers whenever the existence of 9 those salts, isomers, or salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation: 10 11 (1) gamma-hydroxybutyric acid (GHB) (some other names include 12 gamma-hydroxybutyrate; 4-hydroxybutyrate; 4-hydroxybutanoic acid; sodium 13 oxybate; sodium oxybutyrate); 14 (2) when intended or used for human consumption:

1	(A) gamma butyrolactone (GBL);
2	(B) 1,4 butanediol (BD);
3	(C) gamma hydroxyvalerate (GHV);
4	(D) gamma-valerolactone 4-pentanolide (GVL).
