Proclaiming July 24, 2005, as Parents' Day.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the United States Congress has proclaimed that the fourth Sunday in July of each year be celebrated as Parents' Day; and

WHEREAS parents are the foundation of the family and a cornerstone of community life in America, instilling in children the values, attitudes, and guidance needed to become strong individuals and caring citizens; and

WHEREAS the family is important because it provides protection for its youngest and eldest members, helps children cultivate relationships and develop a sense of meaning and place in society, and provides the guidelines of integrity, excellence, and moral character; and

WHEREAS parents are best positioned to influence the growth and development of their children, teaching and modeling for them how to choose right from wrong, to be selfless, and to display compassionate concern for others; and

WHEREAS parents need support and understanding in rearing their children; and
WHEREAS the observance of Parents' Day serves as a reminder of the indispensable
