4	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
5	to read:
6	LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the legislature that nothing in this Act is
7	intended to conflict with the constitutional authority of the Local Boundary Commission to
8	consider any proposed local government boundary change, including borough incorporation.
9	* Sec. 2. AS 44.33.812(a) is amended to read:
10	(a) The Local Boundary Commission shall
11	(1) make studies of local government boundary problems;
12	(2) adopt regulations providing standards and procedures for municipal
13	incorporation, annexation, detachment, merger, consolidation, reclassification, and
14	dissolution;

(3) consider a local government boundary change requested of it by the
legislature, the commissioner of commerce, community, and economic development,
or a political subdivision of the state; "boundary change" may not be construed to
include a borough incorporation; and

(4) develop standards and procedures for the extension of services and ordinances of incorporated cities into contiguous areas for limited purposes upon majority approval of the voters of the contiguous area to be annexed and prepare transition schedules and prorated tax mill levies as well as standards for participation by voters of these contiguous areas in the affairs of the incorporated cities furnishing services.
