4	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 77(d), ch. 10, FSSLA
5	2005, is amended to read:
6	(d) The task force established under (a) of this section
7	(1) may begin work immediately upon the appointment of its full
8	voting membership and shall meet at least three times telephonically or in person;
9	(2) shall hold public hearings and may perform research related to its
10	work;
11	(3) may meet in the interim and vote telephonically;
12	(4) shall report its written findings and give a copy of proposed
13	legislation and other recommendations to the president of the senate and the speaker of

- 1 the house of representatives before **February 15, 2006** [DECEMBER 1, 2005]; and
 - (5) is terminated on **February 28, 2007** [FEBRUARY 1, 2006].
