5	(a) A person who does business as a dealer in the state may not offer to sell or
6	sell a motor vehicle as a new [OR CURRENT MODEL] motor vehicle unless
7	(1) the motor vehicle retains the manufacturer's certificate of origin:

9	(2) the dealer has a current sales and service agreement with the
10	manufacturer of the motor vehicle for sales in this state.
