Establishing a Senate Special Committee on World Trade and State/Federal Relations.

## **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

**WHEREAS** world trade is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

**WHEREAS** legislation enacted by the federal government has far-reaching effects on the economy of the state; and

**WHEREAS** there is renewed interest in the Congress of the United States in exploring the ramifications of federal legislation on the states and their economies; and

**WHEREAS** the legislature should take an active role in exploring opportunities to promote world trade and assist the Congress in understanding the effect of federal legislation on the state's economy;

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on World Trade and State/Federal Relations is established to study issues relating to world trade and state/federal relations; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that the president of the Senate shall determine the number of senators to be members of the committee and shall appoint the members and designate a

member to chair the committee; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Senate Special Committee on World Trade and State/Federal Relations may meet during and between sessions of the Twenty-Fourth Alaska State Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Twenty-Fifth Alaska State Legislature.
