Relating to sales of wine by a winery licensee.

* **Section 1.** AS 04.11.140(b) is amended to read:

(b) The holder of a winery license may sell wine in quantities of

(1) not more than five gallons

(A) to an individual who is present on the licensed premises; or

(B) by shipping to an individual if the shipment is not to an

area that has prohibited the importation or possession of alcoholic

beverages under this chapter or to an area that has limited the

importation or possession of alcoholic beverages unless the sale complies

with the limitation;

(2) more than five gallons to a person who is licensed under this title,

or in another state or country.
