1	Relating to discipline of big game hunting guides and transporters and to providing field
2	accommodations for big game hunters.

4	* <b>Section 1.</b> AS 08.54.710(a) is amended to read:
5	(a) The board may impose a disciplinary sanction in a timely manner under (c)
6	of this section if the board finds [, AFTER A HEARING,] that a licensee
7	(1) is convicted of a violation of any state or federal statute of
8	regulation relating to hunting or to provision of big game hunting services or
9	transportation services;
10	(2) has failed to file records or reports required under this chapter;
11	(3) has negligently misrepresented or omitted a material fact on ar
12	application for any class of guide license or a transporter license; or
13	(4) has breached a contract to provide big game hunting services or
14	transportation services to a client.

11	accommodations by a person described in AS 08.54.785, to a big game hunter in
12	the field, by a person who neither accompanies nor is present with the big game hunter
13	in the field either personally or by an assistant;
