- [A LEGISLATOR OR LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEE MAY NOT 5 (c) 6 SOLICIT, ACCEPT, OR RECEIVE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, 7 COMPASSIONATE GIFTS WORTH LESS THAN \$250 THAT IN A CALENDAR 8 YEAR AGGREGATE TO \$250 OR MORE IN VALUE AND ARE FROM THE 9 SAME PERSON.] A legislator or legislative employee who receives a compassionate 10 gift, directly or indirectly, shall disclose to the committee the name of the gift's source
