8	before January 1, 2001, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and if the
9	applicant satisfies the other criteria established by the board by regulation for
10	receiving the license; or
11	(2) completed a baccalaureate degree, or its equivalent, before
12	January 1, 2008, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and
13	additional semester hours of postbaccalaureate study so that the total educational

- program includes at least 150 hours, and the applicant has three years of
- 2 <u>accounting experience satisfactory to the board.</u>
