3 * **Section 1.** AS 08.04.120(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, the board may grant a license to an
5 applicant who has

6 (1) not completed the 150-hour educational program required by (a) of
7 this section if the applicant has received a baccalaureate degree, or its equivalent,
8 before January 1, 2001, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and if the
9 applicant satisfies the other criteria established by the board by regulation for
10 receiving the license; or

11 (2) completed a baccalaureate degree, or its equivalent, before
12 January 1, 2008, from a college or university acceptable to the board, and
13 additional semester hours of postbaccalaureate study so that the total educational

1 program includes at least 150 hours, and the applicant has three years of
2 accounting experience satisfactory to the board.
