5	* <b>Section 1.</b> AS 44.29.300 is amended to read:
6	Sec. 44.29.300. Council established. There is established in the Department of
7	Health and Social Services the Statewide Suicide Prevention Council, consisting of $\underline{\bf 16}$
8	[15] members, as follows:
9	(1) two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the
10	senate, one of whom shall be a member of the majority and one of whom shall be a
11	member of the minority;
12	(2) two members of the house of representatives, appointed by the
13	speaker of the house of representatives, one of whom shall be a member of the
14	majority and one of whom shall be a member of the minority;

1	(3) $\underline{12}$ [11] members appointed by the governor, as follows:
2	(A) two persons who are employed in the executive branch of
3	state government, one of whom shall represent the Department of Health
4	and Social Services and one of whom shall represent the Department of
5	<b>Education and Early Development</b> ;
6	(B) one member of the Advisory Board on Alcoholism and
7	Drug Abuse;
8	(C) one member of the Alaska Mental Health Board;
9	(D) one person recommended by the Alaska Federation of
10	Natives, Inc.;
11	(E) one person who is <b>an employee of</b> [A COUNSELOR IN] a
12	secondary school;
13	(F) one <b>person</b> [ADULT] who is active in a [STATEWIDE]
14	youth organization;
15	(G) one person who has experienced the death by suicide of a
16	member of the person's family;
17	(H) one person who resides in a rural community in the state
18	that is not connected by road or the Alaska marine highway to the main road
19	system of the state;
20	(I) one person who is a member of the clergy; [AND]
21	(J) one person who is enrolled in grade nine, 10, 11, or 12 of
22	a secondary school in the state; and
23	(K) one public member [UNDER THE AGE OF 18].

25	(b) Members of the council appointed under (a)(1) and (2) of this section are
26	nonvoting members.
27	* <b>Sec. 3.</b> AS 44.29.330(a) is amended to read:
28	(a) The council, by a majority of its <b>voting</b> membership, shall annually elect a
29	presiding officer and other officers it considers necessary from among its membership.
30	* Sec. 4. AS 44.29.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
31	(b) Seven voting members of the council constitute a quorum for the

- transaction of business and the exercise of the powers and duties of the council.
