7	Sec. 30. Sections 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 14, 16, 18, 20, 23, 26, and 27 of this Act take
8	effect on the earlier of the following dates:
9	(1) July 1, <u>2011</u> [2010]; or
10	(2) 90 days after the date the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council
11	notifies the revisor of statutes that in the previous state fiscal year the state did not
12	receive and does not anticipate receiving federal funding for a statewide boating and
13	safety education program; the director of the division of legislative finance shall notify

1	the chair of the Alaska Legislative Council when the state, in the previous fiscal year,
2	did not receive federal funding for a statewide boating and safety program; the chair of
3	the Alaska Legislative Council may not give the notice described in this paragraph
4	unless the notice is approved by a vote of a majority of the members of the Alaska
5	Legislative Council.
