The department may adjust the length of an initial permit so that a permit is not issued for a period of more than 6 7 five years [IS VALID FOR FIVE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF ISSUE]. 8 * Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to 9 read: APPLICABILITY. AS 18.65.700(d), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to 10 11 permits issued and renewed after the effective date of this Act.
