Designating the Alaska Aviation Heritage Museum located at 4721 Aircraft Drive in Anchorage as the official headquarters for the State of Alaska's Centennial of Flight Celebration.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the first flight in the state took place in the summer of 1913 in a Fourth of July exhibition in Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS the State of Alaska will celebrate 100 years of powered flight on July 4, 2013; and

WHEREAS the pioneering and development of flight operations in Alaska is directly tied to the development and growth of the overall infrastructure within the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS aviation within the State of Alaska has served to interconnect the diverse topographies and peoples of the state and has fostered a truly pioneering Alaska spirit;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Alaska Aviation Heritage Museum be designated the official headquarters for the State of Alaska's Centennial

of Flight Celebration and preparations in the year 2013.
