1 Increasing the number of superior court judges designated for the third judicial district; and 2 providing for an effective date. 3 4 * Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read: 5 Sec. 22.10.120. Number of judges. The superior court consists of <u>42</u> [40] 6 judges, five of whom shall be judges in the first judicial district, three of whom shall 7 be judges in the second judicial district, <u>26</u> [24] of whom shall be judges in the third 8 judicial district, and eight of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district. At the 9 time of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill a vacancy on the 10 superior court bench, the judicial council shall also designate the district in which the 11 appointee is to reside and serve. 12 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
