Suspending Rules 47 and 55, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, relating to the carry-over of bills to a special session.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules regarding the carry-over of bills and the provisions of Rule 55 of the Uniform Rules regarding the use of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure, 2012 edition, to cover situations not directly addressed by the Uniform Rules are suspended to the extent they prohibit the carry-over of bills and resolutions from the Second Regular Session to the Third Special Session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska State Legislature; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution applies only to the following bills that relate to the subjects set out in the governor's proclamation for the special session:

House Bill 9 -- In-State Gasline Development Corporation, previously under consideration during the Second Regular Session of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Alaska:

House Bill 359 -- sex crimes; testimony by video conference, previously under consideration during the Second Regular Session of the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the

State of Alaska; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is retroactive to April 18, 2012, at 1:00 p.m., the beginning of the Third Special Session of the Twenty-Seventh Alaska Legislature.
