## AN ACT

4	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 2(c), ch. 63, SLA
5	2012, is amended to read:
6	(c) The task force shall, not later than January 15, 2015 [2013], submit a
7	report to the legislature and the Governor. The report must include
8	(1) policy options to achieve a comprehensive autism spectrum
9	disorder early diagnosis and treatment program that results in coverage to the greates
10	number of residents in the state;
11	(2) recommendations to the legislature and the Governor that include
12	draft legislation required to achieve the policy options proposed by the task force;
13	(3) an evaluation of the fiscal effect of the policy options proposed by

- 1 the task force that includes a five-year projection of both public sector and private 2 sector costs and expenditures; 3 (4) an analysis of how the implementation of P.L. 111-148 (Patient 4 Protection and Affordable Care Act) is expected to affect the options, 5 recommendations, and fiscal evaluations of the task force. 6 \* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska enacted in sec. 2(g), ch. 63, SLA 2012, 7 is amended to read:
- 8 (g) The task force terminates on January 15, **2015** [2013], unless extended.
- 9 \* Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to 10 read:
- 11 RETROACTIVITY. This Act is retroactive to January 14, 2013.
- 12 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
