Within one year after the effective date of this Act, the legislative audit 12 division shall submit an interim report to the legislature concerning compliance by the Board 13 of Certified Direct-Entry Midwives with the recommendations of the June 30, 2014, audit of 14 the board conducted under AS 44.66 and the status of the board's deficit.
