AN ACT

- 8 * Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
- 9 read:
- 10 CONDITIONAL EFFECT. This Act takes effect only if sec. 1 of this Act receives the
- 11 two-thirds majority vote of each house required by art. IV, sec. 15, Constitution of the State of
- 12 Alaska.
- * Sec. 4. If this Act takes effect under sec. 3 of this Act, it takes effect immediately under
- 14 AS 01.10.070(c).
