BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:


#### Abstract

AN ACT

Relating to collecting information about civil litigation by the Alaska Judicial Council; repealing Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e), Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure; and providing for an effective date. * Section 1. Rule 41(a)(3), Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, and Rules 511(c) and (e), Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure, are repealed. *Sec. 2. AS 09.68.130 is repealed. * Sec. 3. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

CONDITIONAL EFFECT. This Act takes effect only if sec. 1 of this Act receives the two-thirds majority vote of each house required by art. IV, sec. 15, Constitution of the State of Alaska. * Sec. 4. If this Act takes effect under sec. 3 of this Act, it takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
