- 1 Suspending Rules 47 and 55, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, relating to
- 2 the carry-over of bills from the First Regular Session and the First Special Session to the
- 3 Second Special Session, concerning House Bill No. 111.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules regarding the carry-over of bills and the provisions of Rule 55 of the Uniform Rules regarding the use of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure to cover situations not directly addressed by the Uniform Rules are suspended in consideration of House Bill No. 111 – An Act relating to credits against the oil and gas production tax; relating to the applicability of certain credits earned under the oil and gas production tax to the tax on corporations; relating to tax credit certificates against the oil and gas production tax and the issuance and assignment of those certificates; relating to interest applicable to delinquent taxes; relating to lease expenditures; and relating to the oil and gas tax credit fund.
