The roll showed seventeen members present. Senator Cowdery was excused from a call of the Senate. Senators Huggins, McGuire were absent.

Senator Ellis moved and asked unanimous consent that Senator Huggins be excused from a call of the Senate today. Without objection, Senator Huggins was excused.

"An Act relating to an optional exemption from municipal property taxes for residences of widows and widowers of certain members of the armed forces of the United States."
