Pursuant to adjournment the Senate was called to order by President Kelly at 10:05 a.m.

The roll showed seventeen members present. Senators Begich, von Imhof were excused from a call of the Senate. Senator MacKinnon was absent.

Senator Micciche moved and asked unanimous consent Senator MacKinnon be excused from a call of the Senate today. Without objection, Senator MacKinnon was excused.

#### **SB 70**

SENATE BILL NO. 70 BY THE SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE, entitled:

"An Act relating to an appropriation limit; relating to the budget responsibilities of the governor; relating to the Alaska permanent fund, the earnings of the Alaska permanent fund, and the earnings reserve account; relating to the mental health trust fund; relating to deposits into the dividend fund; relating to the calculation and payment of permanent fund dividends; and providing for an effective date."

was read the first time. President Kelly referred the bill to the Finance Committee.

Senator Gardner moved and asked unanimous consent to add a State Affairs Committee referral to the bill. President Kelly cited Uniform Rule 39(b) and ruled the referral in order.

Senator Wielechowski appealed the ruling of the Chair.

President Kelly appointed Representative Ortiz and Senator Meyer to escort U.S. Senator Dan Sullivan to the Joint Session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms, Grace Ellsworth, announced the Honorable Dan Sullivan's entrance to the House Chamber.

The Honorable Dan Sullivan was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Kelly.

U.S. Senator Sullivan delivered his address. This address appears in Senate and House Joint Journal Supplement No. 6.

Following his address, there was a question and answer period. U.S. Senator Dan Sullivan received a standing ovation.

Senator Micciche moved and asked unanimous consent that the Joint Session stand in adjournment. Without objection, President Kelly adjourned the Joint Session at 11:30 a.m.
