Senator Micciche moved and asked unanimous consent Senator Giessel be excused from a call of the Senate from May 30 through May 31. Without objection, Senator Giessel was excused.

Message dated May 22 was read stating the Speaker has appointed the following members to a conference committee to meet with a like committee from the Senate to consider the following:

CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 111(FIN)(efd fld) "An Act relating to the oil and gas production tax, tax payments, and credits; relating to interest applicable to delinquent oil and gas production tax; relating to carried-forward lease expenditures based on losses and limiting those lease expenditures to an amount equal to the gross value at the point of production of oil and gas produced from the lease or property where the lease expenditure was incurred; relating to information concerning tax credits, lease expenditures, and oil and gas taxes; relating to the disclosure of that information to the public; relating to an adjustment in the gross value at the point of production; and relating to a legislative working group."
