Representative Thompson moved and asked unanimous consent that Representatives Claman, Kreiss-Tomkins, Rasmussen, and Tuck be excused from a call of the House today. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

The invocation was offered by the Chaplain, Representative Tarr. Representative Drummond moved and asked unanimous consent that the invocation be spread on the journal. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

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Representative Thompson moved and asked unanimous consent that the following committee substitute be adopted in lieu of the original bill:

CS FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2003(FIN) (same title)

Objection was heard and withdrawn. There being no further objection, it was so ordered.

Amendment No. 1 was offered by Representative Eastman:

Page 1, lines 4 - 10:

Delete all material and insert:

"\* Section 1. ALASKA PERMANENT FUND. The amount authorized under AS 37.13.145(b) for transfer by the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation on June 30, 2019, estimated to be \$1,944,000,000, is appropriated from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the dividend fund (AS 43.23.045(a)) for the payment of permanent fund dividends and for administrative and associated costs for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020."

Representative Eastman moved and asked unanimous consent that Amendment No. 1 be adopted.

Representative Wool objected.

The question being: "Shall Amendment No. 1 be adopted?" The roll was taken with the following result:
