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Lipitor® Manufacturer Exclusivity Period

Generic version to cost more than brand

AlaskaCare would like to share important information about an upcoming change in the prescription drug coverage for Lipitor®, a cholesterol lowering medication.

A generic form of Lipitor® called Atorvastatin was introduced around 11/30/2011. Typically, generics should be used whenever available and appropriate to help lower the cost to the plan and the copays for members. However, in this instance, the generic form of Lipitor® will cost more than the brand due to a manufacturer exclusivity period. If you purchase Lipitor, this may affect you in the following ways:

- The generic will not be covered until the pricing is comparable to the pricing for Lipitor®
- You will be charged the generic copay for the brand Lipitor®
 - For retirees, the generic copay is \$4
 - For active employees, the brand and generic copay is 20% of the drug cost and since the brand will be less expensive than the generic, the copay will be less
