**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to delivery of resolutions by the governor."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 24.08.300 is amended to read:

4           **Sec. 24.08.300. Delivery by governor.** When the governor has signed a bill or  
5 allowed it to become law without the governor's signature, and when the governor has  
6 signed or noted resolutions, the governor's office is to deliver the original enrolled  
7 copy of each law or resolution to the executive director of the Legislative Affairs  
8 Agency. **If a resolution is transmitted to the governor while the legislature is in**  
9 **session, the governor shall return the resolution within 15 days, Sundays**  
10 **excepted. If a resolution is transmitted to the governor while the legislature is not**  
11 **in session, the governor shall return the resolution within 20 days, Sundays**  
12 **excepted.** The director shall sign for each bill and resolution, and when it has been  
13 photographed for duplication it shall be returned on receipt to the **Office of the**  
14 **Governor** [OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR].
