### Senator Stedman asked for a table showing past Permanent Fund Statutory Net Income.

Senator Merrick asked how long it would take to retire current school debt if the moratorium is extended.

The current debt schedule shows that debt will remain outstanding through FY40, although the total per year falls under \$1 million beginning in FY37.
