A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to requirements for persons holding provisional drivers' licenses; and**
2 **providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 28.15.055 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (b) A person holding a provisional driver's license shall display in the rear
6 window of each vehicle operated by the person a sticker issued by the department that
7 identifies that the vehicle is operated by a provisional licensee. The department may
8 charge a fee for the issuance of a sticker. Failure to display a sticker as required by this
9 subsection is an infraction and may be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.
10 However, a person charged with violating this section may not be convicted if the
11 person

12 (1) has not previously been arrested, charged, or cited for a violation of
13 this section; and

14 (2) produces in court proof that the person has obtained and affixed the

1 sticker required by this subsection.

2 *** Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2013.
