Analysis

This bill allows vehicles that are at least 25 years old and legally imported into the U.S. to be registered in Alaska without meeting current federal motor vehicle safety standards, and prevents the state from denying or revoking their title for that reason.

The Division of Motor Vehicles does not anticipate a fiscal impact and therefore submits a zero fiscal note.
