


Disasters



- Governed in statute under AS 26.23, Alaska Disaster Act
- Defined in AS 26.23.900(2)
 - Widespread and severe
 - Resulting from an incident caused by weather, nature, or man-made
 - Oil spill/hazardous material spill
 - Mechanical failure (if not predictable, reoccurring or caused by lack of maintenance)
 - Enemy or terrorist attack
 - Cyber attack
 - Outbreak of disease

Disaster Process



- Disaster declaration authorized by AS 26.23.020
 - Limited to 30 days unless extended by the legislature
 - State funding authority is limited to up to \$1M
 - Can activate state assistance programs
 - AS 26.23.020(g) outlines other authorities of the Governor under a state declared disaster
 - (1) Suspend provisions of regulations
 - (2) utilize all available resources of state government



Individual Assistance Program

Individual and Family Grant (IFG)



- Housing
- Personal property
- Transportation
- Medical, dental, or funeral expenses


