**DELETE:** All operating numbers sections (bill sections 1-3)

**Capital Numbers Section:** Change fund source of entire capital numbers section to the Constitutional Budget Reserve (1001)

**EXPLANATION:** See attached language amendment 34-GH2638/H.2 for language section changes. The combined effect of this amendment is to leave only the capital numbers sections with DOT match funding and language sections with fire suppression and disaster relief funding. These sections are funded directly from the CBR.

8 **\*\* Sec. 4. FUND CAPITALIZATION.** (a) The sum of \$40,000,000 is appropriated from the  
9 budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec. 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska) to the disaster relief  
10 fund (AS 26.23.300(a)).

11 (b) The sum of \$35,000,000 is appropriated from the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec.  
12 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska) to the disaster relief fund (AS 26.23.300(a)).

13 (c) The sum of \$98,715,900 is appropriated from the budget reserve fund (art. IX, sec.  
14 17, Constitution of the State of Alaska) to the fire suppression fund (AS 41.15.210) for fire  
15 suppression activities.

16 **\* Sec. 5. CONSTITUTIONAL BUDGET RESERVE FUND.** The appropriations made from  
17 the constitutional budget reserve fund in secs. 1 and 4 of this Act are made under art. IX, sec.  
18 17(c), Constitution of the State of Alaska.

19 **\* Sec. 6. LAPSE.** (a) The appropriations made in sec. 1 of this Act are for capital projects  
20 and lapse under AS 37.25.020.

21 (b) The appropriations made in sec. 4 of this Act are for the capitalization of funds  
22 and do not lapse.

23 **\* Sec. 7. CONTINGENCY.** The appropriation made in sec. 4(b) of this Act is contingent on

1 the state's match rate as of June 30, 2026, remaining at 25 percent of the state's costs for  
2 disaster relief under the Federal Emergency Management Agency's major disaster declaration  
3 for the state because of Typhoon Halong (FEMA-4893-DR).

4 \* **Sec. 8.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c)."
